



Recommended learning path for those new to Microsoft licensing

Overview

The Microsoft Body of Knowledge 2025 Foundation exam is aimed at individuals who want to show that they have a basic knowledge across the licensing of Microsoft's desktop and server workloads (with the emphasis on cloud solutions), and how customers can purchase the licenses they need.

The exam must be completed in 40 minutes, and consists of 30 questions split into three sections:

- Desktop licensing
- Server licensing
- Ways to buy Microsoft licenses

Candidates with a passing score of 70% or above are awarded a digitally verifiable [Credly badge](#) demonstrating their ability to recall key licensing facts and apply their knowledge in real-world customer licensing scenarios.

This certification is especially useful in career development programs for sales, deployment, procurement, licensing specialist, and SAM professionals.

Getting started: Licensing Scholar Core

If you're new to Microsoft licensing, taking a single exam on all these areas of licensing can be an overwhelming place to start. So, we'd recommend working through our Licensing Scholar Core program. This is a series of four modules that cover all the content required to pass the Foundation exam, but in bite sized chunks. Each module consists of a training webinar run by Louise Ulrick and a 10-question test to check your knowledge in that area. You can listen to the training as often as you want, and take the tests as often as you need to; the pass mark for all exams is 70%. The questions aren't the same as in the Foundation exam, so don't try and learn the answers!

You might want to do a module a day if you're on a fast track, or a module a week if you want to take things at a more moderate pace. You can ask questions about the training by emailing training@licensingschool.co.uk, and ask questions about the exams by emailing exams@licensingschool.co.uk.

When you've passed all four exams you'll be awarded a Credly badge for you to celebrate the progress that you've made so far. Share this on LinkedIn and in your email signature to establish your rising credibility in the world of Microsoft licensing.

Using your triple-shot Foundation exam link

You will have been sent a link to take the Foundation exam – reach out to your Account Manager if you need it to be resent to you. The link is used with a code unique to you, and gives you three attempts to take the exam. We'd recommend that when you've completed the Licensing Scholar Core program, you use one of your attempts to benchmark yourself against the requirements of the exam. When you have completed the exam, you get feedback on how you've done in the three different sections, as shown in the picture below, and it will give you an idea of any areas you need to work on:

Of course, if you pass the exam on that first attempt then that's great! As time goes on, you may want to refresh the core knowledge that you've gained, or learn more about licensing, and this is when you should use [LicenseVerse](#).
