

## Get more out of your existing Windows Server licenses

Now you can move your existing Windows Server licenses to Azure, just as you can with other popular Microsoft solutions, such as SQL Server and SharePoint. Take advantage of this benefit to extend your datacenter to the cloud.

Reduced pricing. With the Azure Hybrid Use Benefit, you can use onpremises Windows Server licenses that include Software Assurance to earn special pricing for new Windows Server virtual machines in Azure. You pay only for the base compute rate, which is currently the same as the Linux rate for virtual machines.

Cloud-ready licenses. Using this benefit can help organizations extend into the cloud, whether for a few workloads or for an entire datacenter.

Incredible value. If your licenses don't already include Software Assurance, a program that includes rights to new software releases and cost-efficient upgrades, this could be a good time to reconsider. With Software Assurance, you could save up to 50 percent on Azure instances, depending on usage, instance type, and location. Contact your Microsoft account team to add Software Assurance.

## Datacenter Edition licenses with Software Assurance

- Deploy two VMs with up to 8 cores each for each twoprocessor license.
- Save up to 50 percent on Azure deployments.
- Use each license on-premises and in Azure.

## Standard Edition licenses with Software Assurance

- Deploy two VMs with up to 8 cores each for each twoprocessor license.
- Save up to 50 percent on Azure deployments.
- Use each license once, either on-premises or in Azure.

Before Azure Hybrid Use Benefit: Annual cost of one Windows Server virtual machine on Azure \$4,555

## How Azure Hybrid Use Benefit works:

- Determine eligibility. For each Windows
   Server two-processor license with Software
   Assurance, customers may run two virtual
   machines with up to 8 cores each, or one
   virtual machine with up to 16 cores, at the
   lower price.
- Upload the image files. Use Windows
   PowerShell to create each Windows Server virtual machine on-premises, flag it for the Azure Hybrid Use Benefit, and upload it to Azure.
- Watch savings add up. Your charges will be calculated at non-Windows virtual machine rates.
