

Licensing System Center 2019 on-premises

Licensing model

With System Center 2019, only the endpoints to be managed need licenses, with no differentiation between server workloads. Rights to SQL Server and the Management Server software are included.



System Center 2019 Server Management Licenses (MLs)

Core-based licensing

- System Center 2019 Standard and Datacenter Server MLs are core-based licenses
- A Server ML Core license must be assigned to each physical core in the server, with a minimum of 8 Core licenses per processor, and a minimum of 16 Core licenses per server. For example, a single processor server with 4 cores requires 16 Server ML Core licenses, and a 4-processor server with 8 cores on each processor requires 32 Server ML Core licenses



 Server ML Core licenses are purchased in 2-packs or 16-packs from resellers, and always include Software Assurance

Servicing Branches

- System Center 2019 is supported by the Long-Term Servicing Branch with 5 years of mainstream and 5 years of extended support. In addition, new features are made available every six months through Update Rollup releases during the mainstream support period
- Microsoft Endpoint Configuration Manager is also supported by a Current Branch release cadence which provides feature updates three times a year. The LTSB of Configuration Manager is intended for customers with perpetual licenses who have let their SA expire

Additional Software Assurance benefits available

The following SA benefits are also available for System Center 2019 Server Management Licenses:

- 24x7 Problem Resolution Support
- Disaster Recovery Rights
- Planning Services
- Self-Hosting Use Rights

Note that License Mobility across Server Farms is NOT available as an SA benefit.

System Center 2019 Client Management Licenses Availability

- System Center Endpoint Protection 1606 SL
- System Center 2019 Data Protection Manager CML
- System Center 2019 Orchestrator CML

Licensing rules

- Software Assurance is included with all Client MLs
- Client MLs can be licensed per OSE or per User
- Endpoint Protection SLs can be licensed per Device or per User
- Client MLs include the right to run the Management Server software and SQL Server

Licensing virtual machines/containers

System Center 2019 Datacenter

- The server must be fully licensed with Server ML Core licenses (as described in the Core-based Licensing section)
- An unlimited number of virtual machines may be managed on the server

System Center 2019 Standard

- The server must be fully licensed with Server ML Core licenses (as described in the Core-based Licensing section)
- 2 virtual machines may be managed on the server
- The server must be licensed again to manage a further 2 virtual machines. For example, a single processor server with 8 cores requires 16 Server ML Core licenses to manage 2 VMs. A further 16 Server ML Core licenses must be assigned to the server to manage another 2 VMs

Windows Server Containers

- Any number of Windows Server Containers without Hyper-V isolation may be managed on licensed servers
- The rules for licensing Windows Server Containers with Hyper-V isolation are exactly the same as for virtual machines detailed above

Step-up licenses

Customers who have existing System Center 2019 Standard Server ML Core licenses with Software Assurance may purchase Step-Up licenses to move to System Center

2019 Datacenter Server ML Core licenses

The Step-Up license is priced at the difference in price of the two licenses and SA.
