Deployment options

Network server/Authorized Outsourcer

Scenario:

Hardware owned and managed by the customer or an Authorized Outsourcer, dedicated to that customer's use

Details:

All server products are eligible

Authorized Outsourcer

Scenario:

Hardware shared between customers, managed by an Authorized Outsourcer. An Authorized Outsourcer is a partner providing hosting solutions who isn't a Listed Provider

CSP perpetual licenses	✗

Details:

All server products are eligible, including Windows Server

Listed Provider

Scenario:

Dedicated host cloud services provided by Alibaba, Amazon, or Google

CSP perpetual licenses	✗

Details:

Products must be eligible for the [License Mobility through SA](#) benefit. Most products are included, but Windows Server **is not**

Azure Dedicated Host

Scenario:

Microsoft's dedicated hardware solution when acting as a Listed Provider

Details:

Products must be eligible for the [License Mobility through SA](#) benefit, or the [Azure Hybrid Benefit](#). Windows Server **is** included via the [Azure Hybrid Benefit](#)

Authorized Mobility Partner

Scenario:

Multi-tenant solutions provided by Authorized Mobility Partners. An Authorized Mobility Partner is also called a License Mobility through SA partner

Details:

Products must be eligible for the [License Mobility through SA](#) benefit. Most products are included, but Windows Server **is not**

Azure shared hardware

Microsoft's multi-tenant solutions in Azure when acting as an Authorized Mobility Partner

License Mobility through SA

Eligibility:

- Product eligibility is detailed at the Product Terms website

Applicable products:

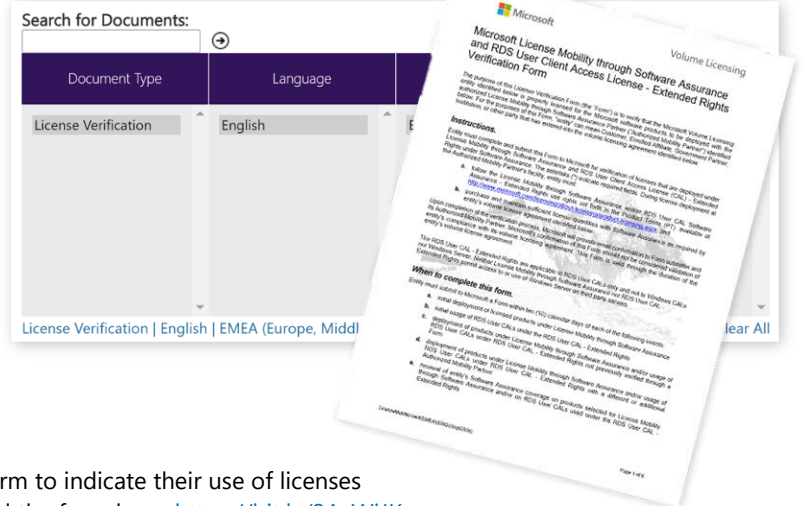
- Exchange, SharePoint, Skype for Business Server, Project Server
- Dynamics 365 Operations Server, BizTalk Server, System Center
- SQL Server

Notable exceptions:

- Windows Server

Process:

Azure Hybrid Benefit

Applicable products:

- Windows Server and SQL Server
- Licenses purchased through a Volume Licensing agreement must have active Software Assurance. Software Subscriptions purchased through CSP also include this benefit

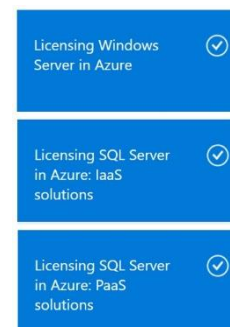
Licensing virtual machines:

- Licenses may be assigned to virtual machines running in Azure Dedicated Host or on Azure shared hardware
- License minimums:
 - Windows Server – 8 Core licenses per virtual machine
 - SQL Server – 4 Core licenses per virtual machine

Azure SQL database service:

- SQL Server licenses may alternatively be used to cover Azure SQL database virtual cores

Azure Dedicated Host

Overview:

- Azure Dedicated Host is an Azure service that provides physical servers, able to host one or more Azure virtual machines for Windows or Linux, which are dedicated to a single organization and their workloads
- The server capacity is not shared with other customers

Licensing the host:

- A type of Azure Dedicated Host is chosen and paid for on a pay-as-you-go basis or with a Reservation
- Each Azure Dedicated Host type is restricted to a single virtual machine family. Any virtual machines from the family can be chosen within the core capacity limits of the host ie the total of the virtual machine cores cannot exceed the available vCPUs of the host

Licensing the virtual machine software:

- Via a meter based on usage
- Bring existing licenses via the Azure Hybrid Benefit and follow the usual rules for licensing individual virtual machines
- Bring existing licenses via the Azure Hybrid Benefit, and license all of the available cores in the physical host for unlimited virtualization for Windows Server Datacenter and SQL Server Enterprise licenses
