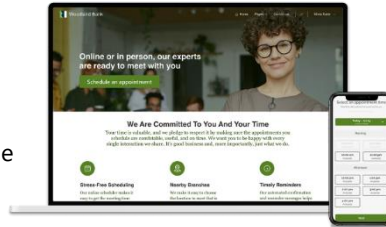


Licensing Power Pages

Introduction to Power Pages

Microsoft Power Pages is a secure, enterprise-grade, low-code software as a service (SaaS) platform for creating, hosting, and administering modern external-facing business websites. Whether you're a low-code maker or a professional developer, Power Pages empowers you to rapidly design, configure, and publish websites that work across web browsers and devices.

Overview of Power Pages licensing

Users

Authenticated

- Users who obtain access to a website by logging in through an authentication provider

Anonymous

- Users who browse a website and don't log in

Both authenticated and anonymous users may access a single Power Pages site

Commitment Type

Capacity Licenses

- Predictable costs with volume-based plans that scale

PAYG

- The option to pay only when a user accesses a website

Power Pages sites are assigned to an environment which must be licensed with EITHER capacity licenses OR the PAYG option

Capacity licenses

Authenticated users

Organizations purchase 12-month user capacity licenses for the anticipated number of unique, authenticated users (internal or external) accessing a website during a month.

Tiers	Minimum requirement	Users per license	Price per license
Tier 1	100 users	100	\$200
Tier 2	10,000 users	100	\$75
Tier 3	100,000 users	100	\$50

Anonymous users

Organizations purchase 12-month user capacity licenses for the anticipated number of unique, anonymous users accessing a website during a month.

Tiers	Minimum requirement	Users per license	Price per license
Tier 1	500 users	500	\$75
Tier 2	10,000 users	500	\$37.50
Tier 3	100,000 users	500	\$25

Note that a user logging in multiple times to one website in a calendar month is counted as one user, and unused capacity does not roll over to subsequent months.

Pay-As-You-Go option

An Azure Subscription is used to pay only for the number of unique users who **authenticate** on a website each month:
\$4 per user/site/month

An Azure Subscription is used to pay only for the number of unique users who browse a website **anonymously** each month:
\$0.30 per user/site/month

Dataverse

Dataverse lets you store and manage data used by Power Apps. Websites utilising Dataverse will consume varying quantities of Dataverse Database, File, and Log capacity. The first capacity license purchased receives default capacity assigned to a tenant, and then further licenses accrue additional capacity across the tenant.

Authenticated users capacity license

- Default entitlement: 5 GB of Database capacity
- Accrued entitlement: 2 GB of Database and 16 GB of File capacity

Anonymous users capacity license

- Default entitlement: 5 GB of Database capacity
- Accrued entitlement: 500 MB of Database and 4 GB of File capacity

Pay-As-You-Go

1 GB of Dataverse Database capacity and 1 GB of Dataverse File capacity is allocated as default capacity to a PAYG environment. There is no accrued capacity. Additional capacity used is charged on Database, File or Log capacity meters.
