

Licensing Power Apps

Introduction to Power Apps

Power Apps helps organizations solve the “app gap”. There’s a growing demand for apps as organizations attempt to replace manual processes with digital processes, but there aren’t enough developers to build these apps.

Traditionally, some processes have been solved with off-the-shelf SaaS solutions but there isn’t always “an app for that”. Other processes have been solved by traditional custom app development, but there is only so much traditional custom app development an organization can invest in. Power Apps is a low-code development platform that can help address this “app gap” with end users, the IT department and professional developers able to create organization-specific apps quickly and easily.



Licensing Power Apps

Power Apps Premium

\$20 per user per month

- A single license enables a user to access any number of apps and Power Pages websites across any environments
- Licenses are assigned to users via the Microsoft 365 Admin Center

Power Apps per App

\$5 per user per month

- A single license enables a user to access 1 app or 1 Power Pages website
- Licenses are assigned to one environment via the Power Platform Admin Center
- Licenses are allocated to users when an app in an environment is shared with a user

Best for businesses that want predictable user-based licensing

Power Apps per App Pay-As-You-Go

\$10 per active user per app per month

- An environment is linked to an Azure Subscription for PAYG billing
- Active users, who use an app, are billed monthly against the Subscription
- App licenses assigned to a PAYG environment are not used

Best for businesses that want the agility to only pay when a user runs an app

Power Apps use rights included with Office 365 licenses

Select Microsoft 365 and Office 365 licenses include Power Apps functionality, where users with these licenses can create and access any number of apps using standard connectors. See [this resource](#) for a list of connectors and classifications.

Dataverse

Dataverse lets you store and manage data used by Power Apps. Apps utilizing Dataverse will consume varying quantities of Dataverse Database, File, and Log capacity.

Power Apps Premium and Per App

The first Power Apps Premium or Per App license receives default capacity assigned to a tenant, and then further licenses accrue additional capacity across the tenant. Capacity Add-on licenses are also available to purchase extra capacity in increments of 1 GB.

Power Apps per App

Capacity	Default	Accrued
Database	5 GB	50 MB
File	20 GB	400 MB
Log	2 GB	-

Pay-As-You-Go

1 GB of Dataverse Database capacity and 1 GB of Dataverse File capacity is allocated as default capacity to a PAYG environment. There is no accrued capacity. Additional capacity used is charged on Database, File or Log capacity meters.
