**Microsoft Licensing Programs** 

Dragon Copilot subscription licenses can be purchased through:

- Microsoft Customer Agreement (MCA)
- Microsoft Cloud Solution Provider, including ISV Cloud Embed

When the Microsoft Cloud Agreement is not an option for customers, Dragon Copilot subscriptions may be purchased through:

- Enterprise Agreement (EA)
- Enterprise Agreement Subscription (EAS)
- Server Cloud Enrollment (SCE)
- Enrollment for Education Solutions (EES)

# **Product Licensing**

Any user that inputs data into, queries, views data within Dragon Copilot or otherwise accesses Dragon Copilot directly or indirectly must be properly licensed. Dragon Copilot can be purchased through either a per user subscription license or a combination of per user subscription license plus pay as you go meter.

### A Single Subscription License

Dragon Copilot Per User is a single user license, which includes all features such as Front-endspeech, ambient features, and genAl features.

### A Blended Business Model of User License and Pay As You Go Consumption

Dragon Copilot Flex user license provides access to Dragon Copilot and includes usage of Frontend-speech. However, to utilize the ambient and genAl features, you must link an Azure subscription to the customer environment in Dragon Admin Center to enable pay as you go consumption of the features.

**Note:** An environment in Dragon Admin Center is a container in which you can provision and configure your healthcare solutions.

#### Services Overview

Microsoft Dragon Copilot brings together the trusted natural language voice dictation capabilities of Dragon Medical One, with the ambient listening capabilities of DAX Copilot, finetuned generative AI, and healthcare-adapted safeguards. This unified experience integrates with EHRs and supports clinicians across all stages of their workflow. Part of Microsoft Cloud for Healthcare, it's an extensible workspace that's built on a secure modern architecture that enables organizations to deliver enhanced experiences and outcomes across care settings for providers and patients alike.

If a user has previously licensed PowerMic Mobile from Nuance, they can use supported versions of PowerMic Mobile together with Dragon Copilot, according to the restrictions and terms in the customer agreement associated with the purchase of PowerMic Mobile.

### Licensing Overview

Dragon Copilot capabilities are licensed via Dragon Copilot subscriptions on a per user basis and via pay as you go enabling licensed users to run the application.

A high-level overview of the licensing structure is provided below.

Licensing scheme	Per User	Per User	Consumption
Description	Equips user to run all Dragon Copilot features without additional need.	Provides access to all features but requires an Azure subscription to run ambient and GenAl features as consumption.	Allows users with a Dragon Copilot flex license to access all ambient and GenAl features but only pay for the features used. Requires Azure subscription linked.

**Note:** A customer can buy a mix of licenses and assign licenses to users within their organization according to <u>Microsoft Product Terms</u>.

### Dragon Copilot Per User Subscription License

This license is recommended for customers that want to provide access to all Dragon Copilot features with a single user subscription license. The Dragon Copilot Per User subscription license is intended to support the broad adoption by clinicians within an organization.

### Dragon Copilot Flex Subscription License

This license is recommended for customers who wish to only pay for the ambient and GenAI features they use through pay as you go consumption.

**Note:** To equip users with ambient and GenAI features, an Azure subscription needs to be linked to the user environment in Dragon Admin Center, see below.

## Pay As You Go Consumption Unit

The Dragon Copilot pay as you go consumption unit meter enables individual users to run ambient and GenAl features within the application. This option is best for businesses that want to pay as you go for only the users who apply the ambient and GenAl capabilities.

To use Dragon Copilot ambient and GenAl features through pay as you go, customers must have purchased the Dragon Copilot Flex subscription license and assigned to the users as a prerequisite.

The usage of ambient and GenAl capabilities are counted as consumption units that are accumulated across the customer tenant as pay as you go. Different features require different amounts of consumption units (See the pricing information details).
